Board Elections

- Board will be occurring at the May General CoC Meeting
- Members must be current on their dues and submitted their applications
- Currently 7 applications have been received
- June will be utilized as an onboarding month for new board members and then term will begin July 1, 2022

Funding

- ESG, Challenge, and TANF grants will be renewed at the same level and for the same amount and the CoC will have
- ESG funded \$257,000 (Rapid Rehousing, Homeless Prevention, Street Outreach, Emergency Shelter HMIS, Administrative Fees)
- Challenge \$86,000 (Help CoC to achieve goals of strategic plan)
- TANF \$32,250 (Families at or below 200% below poverty)

ESG Cares Contract

- HUD announced an extension for expenditure through September 2023
- The state of Florida's expenditure deadline is June 30

Veteran Homelessness

- Establishing a Veteran Strategic Plan
- Reaching functional zero in the next 18 months
